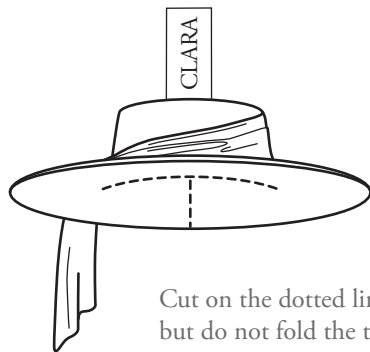


Clara's Long Tunic and Skirt
