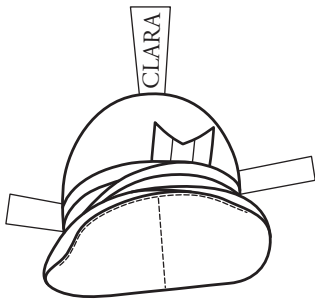


Clara's 1923 Dropped Waist Dress
