

Clara's 1950s Pedal Pushers

Pants had become suitable for women to wear during World War II, when women wore trousers to work in factories in place of the men who were at war. By the 1950s, many styles of pants were worn, including these short pants, known by many names: pedal pushers, three-quarters shorts, capris, or clam diggers. Clara also has a long tunic for a blouse, with geometric trim at the neck, and large pockets. To finish off her outfit, Clara has some simple ballet flats.

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
