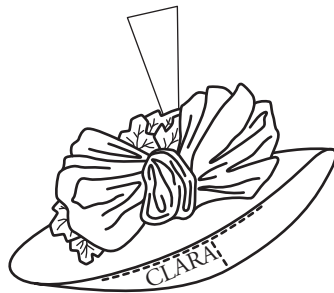
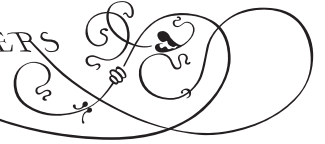


Clara's 1890 Day Dress
