

Clara's 1950s Poodle Skirt

The poodle skirt was a popular style in the 1950s. The skirt is sewn from a full circle of cloth, usually felt, with a wide band or belt at the waist. Many of the skirts of this style featured a poodle, but cats, cars, or other appliques were also worn on the circle skirts. The blouse is a nice button-up shirt with some wide turned-up cuffs on the sleeves. Clara's shoes are saddle shoes, of course, worn with bobby socks.
