

Clara's 1910s Dropped Waist Dress

During the 1910s, fashion designs became softer and less tailored than those of the previous decade. Clara's dress has a blousy top, and a slightly dropped waist. The sleeves are also slightly puffed, and are cut at 3/4 length and finished with a wide cuff. This dress is pretty simple, with only some pleats on the bodice and small ruffles at the neck and sleeve. And, surprisingly, Clara's shoes are boots, not exactly what you might expect to be worn with a dress, but boots were very practical, and were worn with day dresses in the early 1900s. Finally, to dress up her outfit, Clara has a cute little hairbow.
