PAPER DOLLS BY BOWERS ADVILIMClara's dress has the typical silhouette of a fashion design from the 1840s. Sloping shoulders became the height of fashion, along with sleeves that dropped below the shoulder. The v-neck style, and dropped waist are also typical of dresses from this time period. Roses trim the draped 3/4 length sleeves, which frame the halfgloves worn as a fashion accessory. The ruffled split overskirt is worn over a finely pleated underskirt, which was worn over many petticoats, and pantalettes worn to cover the legs to the ankle. Clara also has a straw bonnet trimmed with roses and ruffles, tied at the chin with a huge bow. And last of all, a fine pair of boots finish off the ensemble. These boots do not have a left or right foot, so both shoes could be worn interchangeably on either foot. **CLARA** CUT OUT Cut out the space, and tuck the top half under the head to hold the hat securely.
